Current Costs

According to the National Funeral Directors Association the average cost for funeral merchandise and services is over \$6,100.

Additional Costs

1. Medical bills, medications and home health care not covered by insurance.
2. Transportation costs and lost wages for children to attend services.
3. Income continuance due to social security and pension reductions.
4. Legal/Probate fees. Attorney, filing and court fees.
5. Unpaid household bills. Mortgage, utility, department store charge accounts and credit card balances.
6. Frozen checking account.
7. Forwarding remains to another funeral home.
8. Unpaid federal, state, and local income taxes and estate taxes.
